Business Volunteer Council Membership - \$500

Recommended for companies with under 25 employees.

- Receive one *Group Volunteer Project Book* listing current service opportunities for employees.
- Receive the Corporate Volunteer Handbook outlining how to start a volunteer team.
- Attend trainings at a discount: *Open the Board Room Door: Choosing to Serve*, and *Project Leadership*.
- Your company name appears on all membership lists.
- Receive a variety of publications and invitations from the Nonprofit Center.

Basic Membership - \$1,000

Recommended for companies with 25 - 250 employees. Includes all of the BVC member services above, plus:

- Receive two *Group Volunteer Project Books* listing current service opportunities for employees
- Conduct an Employee Volunteer Assessment Survey designed and tabulated by the Volunteer Center.

Premier Membership - \$2,000

Recommended for companies with over 250 employees. Includes all of the BVC and Basic member services, plus:

- Receive three *Group Volunteer Project Books* listing current service opportunities for employees.
- On request, our staff representative will attend your volunteer team meetings.
- Receive personal service in finding projects for your team.
- An *Open the Board Room Door* workshop conducted at your company for a discounted fee — the focus is board and committee service.
- Collaboration opportunities to educate and encourage staff to serve on nonprofits boards and committees (i.e. a presentation; panel, lunch-and-learn).
- Receive personal service to connect your staff with board and committee opportunities.
